Brett Moss discuss the country's first Net Zero Energy Plus training facility in Los Angeles and explore how their approach can work in Michigan.

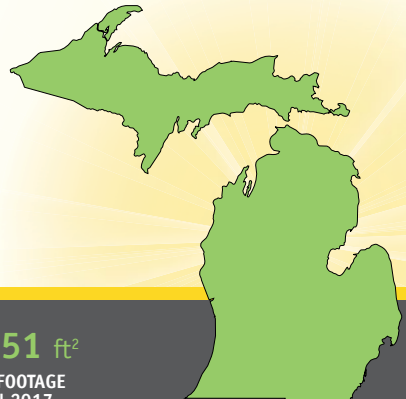

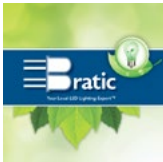
